**Session One: 09:15-10:35 – The power of one rep**

- 1) Group Formation (groups made up of S1-6 pupils and P7 pupils)
- 2) Introduction – K Lane
- 3) Card sort – what makes a good rep.
- 4) Post-it – what can YOU do to make a difference
- 5) Importance of one person becoming ONE group
- 6) Egg Drop Challenge (in year groups, primary pupils working together supported by two S6 pupils) Each group will have an observer who records how the group works together.
- 7) Feedback and Eggs-cellent prizes

**Session Two: 11:05-12:30 – The power of communication**

- 1) Back into mixed groups – look at main issue of how to communicate to wider community
- 2) Complete communication plan task
- 3) Feedback
- 4) Introduction to Pupil Voice Twitter Account
- 5) Pupils write Twitter Vision Statement for what "the Power of One" can do. They then assess and work on their statements and each group submits the best three. These will be tweeted for next few weeks to encourage pupils to follow twitter account.
- 6) The issues affecting one...(may be carried on past lunchtime if needed)  
Pupils complete a placemat looking at issues affecting one pupil, one year group, one school and one community.  
Pupils then come together to pick out the most important issues for each year group (in year groups, primary pupils working together supported by two S6 pupils) and then in mixed groups for school.

**Session Three: 13:15-15:10 – The power of one pupil council**

Year groups met with their link teacher(s) to begin work on the issues that they wish to look at. Pupils should also sign up to Edmodo and elect school reps. Teachers will be provided with resources to help planning and this should be used to start off this term's issue
